Introduction

Who is it for?

The Florence Nightingale Foundation is pleased to announce our first Research Scholarship with St Barnabas House.

St Barnabas House provides specialist palliative care to adults with life-limiting illnesses, both within the hospice and in the comfort of patients' homes across West Sussex.

This Research Scholarship is to implement St Barnabas House's research strategy to enable research activity across the organisations. This scholarship is suitable for nurses who have a working knowledge of the National Institute of Health Research (NIHR) Clinical Research Network (CRN).

Funding is available for a for a band six or a seven nurse to be seconded to St Barnabas House for two days per week, for nine months to work with the St Barnabas team. Interest in palliative and end of life care would be desirable but not essential.

A travel budget is also included.

A letter of support, to be released from your employer, must accompany your application.

Professor Greta Westwood www.florence-nightingale-foundation.org.uk/about/team/ will provide mentorship (1/2 day per month) throughout this project.

The Project will commence in March 2019.

How do you apply?

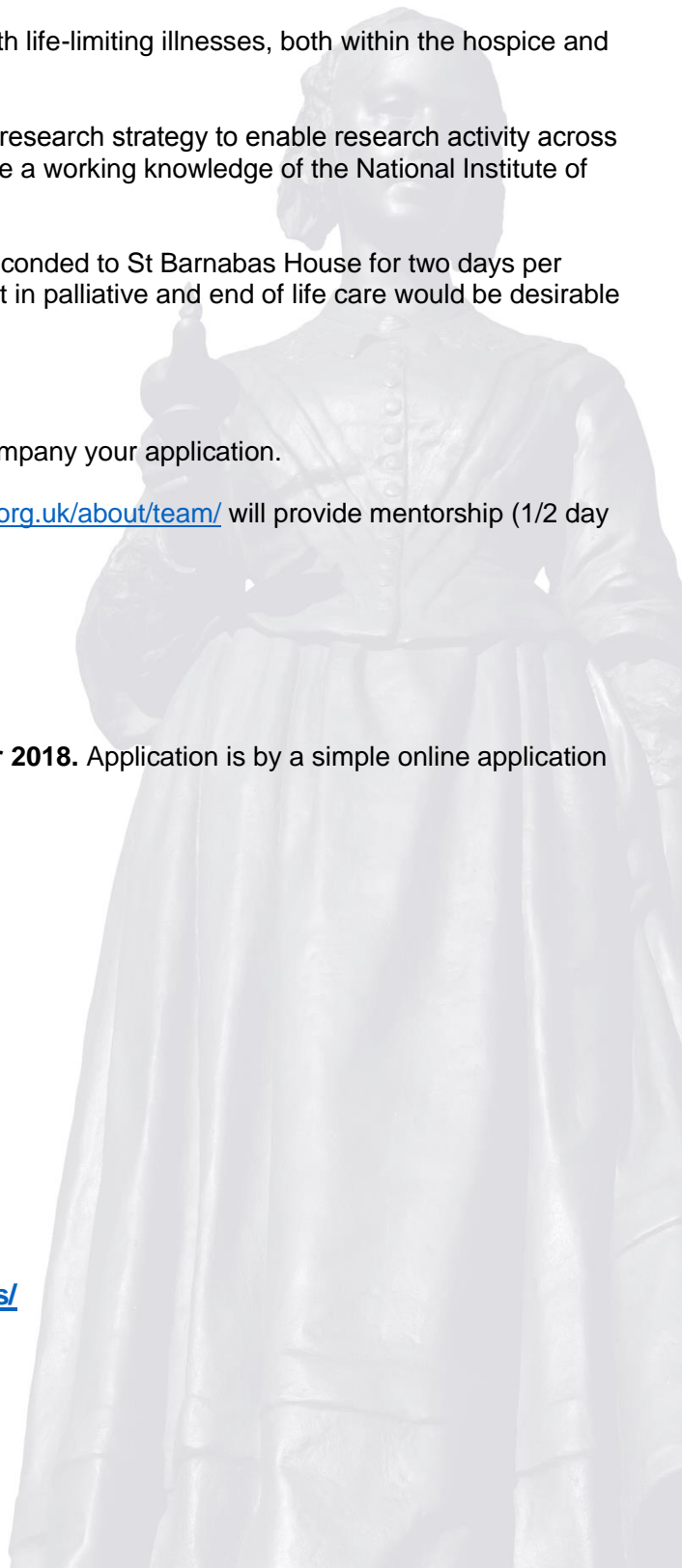
Applications will **open on 27th July 2018 and close 14th October 2018**. Application is by a simple online application form. Please see the link below.
