

Professor Euan Hails MBE



Professor Hails is Consultant Nurse at the Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services, Aneurin Bevan University Health Board, a Visiting Professor at the University of South Wales and an Associate Professor at the Medical School Swansea University. He was awarded an MBE in the Queen's New Year's Honours List of 2022 for services to children and young people's mental health in Wales.

He has been working as a mental health nurse since 1984. He was a Trustee and Vice Chair of the mental health charity Hafal and is now the Director of Therapeutic and Clinical Governance at Adferiad Recovery. He is the Chair and a Fellow of the National Council of Integrative Psychotherapists, Fellow of the Bevan Commission, and the Higher Education Academy, and a Trustee of the Counselling in Prisons Network. He is a Member of RCN Wales Board and the RCN children and young people's mental health experts reference group.

Euan was a finalist in the RCNi Nursing Awards Mental Health category in 2020, and a Florence Nightingale Aspiring Directors Digital Leadership Scholarship graduate. He sits on the Welsh CAMHS Board, the All Wales Senior Nurse Mental Health and Paediatric Advisory Groups and is Vice Chair of the All Wales CAMHS Peer Review process. He is active member of the Welsh First Episode Psychosis Network and supervises clinically the developing Irish First Episode Psychosis services.
